

Facilities Sub-Committee  
Of the  
Saugeen Shores Police Service Board

Mandate:

The purpose of the Facilities Sub-Committee is to make a recommendation to the Saugeen Shores Police Service Board on the direction that should be taken with regards to the future facilities and infrastructure needs of the Saugeen Shores Police Service.

Terms of Reference:

The Facilities Sub-Committee shall utilize all available information including but not limited to, current and past Business Plans, Annual Reports, Facilities Condition Reports, and Architectural Designs etc., in order to formulate a recommendation. In addition, the Facilities Sub-Committee shall attend 2 public consultation/input sessions on July 14 and August 17 2016 in order to receive feedback on matters of Policing, as they refer to current facilities and future capital investment in facilities and infrastructure.

Composition:

The Facilities Sub-Committee shall be comprised of all current members of the Saugeen Shores Police Service Board, at least one member representative of the Saugeen Shores Police Service, and at least two members of the public, solicited and selected in the same manner as any other town Sub-Committee.

Duration and Frequency of meetings:

The Facilities Sub-Committee shall provide the SSPSB with its recommendations by the end of September 2016 for submission to the Town of Saugeen Shores business-planning process. It is expected that the committee shall meet at least once monthly, in addition to attendance at the two public input sessions. The Sub-Committee shall be dissolved at the conclusion of this mandate.
